

## RoHS declaration

Dear customer,

The European Union directive 2011/65/EU (previously 2002/95/EC) on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) entered into force on 03 January 2013.

This directive applies to the following named substances:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI)
- Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (pentaBDE, octaBDE; decaBDE)
- Perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS)

WEBER- HYDRAULIK GmbH, all 100% subsidiaries as well as all joint ventures controlled by the WEBER-HYDRAULIK Group hereby confirm the conformity of our relevant products to the RoHS directive 2011/65/EU as well as compliance with the permissible maximum concentration in homogeneous materials in terms of percent by weight of < 0.01% for cadmium and of < 0.1% for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium (Cr6+), polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) in accordance with Annex II of the directive.
